Patient management and local referral information all in one place.

Clinicians in the North Brisbane and Moreton Bay region can access clinical pathways online via HealthPathways, which provides the user with point-of-care guidance for the assessment and management of medical conditions, as well as available local services and how to refer to them.

Where available referral criteria, including Queensland Health's Clinical Prioritisation Criteria guidelines, are embedded in the pathways.

Local HealthPathways at a glance

Over 400 pathways have been localised for the North Brisbane and Moreton Bay region.

These consist of clinical, referral, service and resource pages, which cover a wide range of specialties.

As part of the quality assurance and localisation process, a specialist in the field reviews each pathway for accuracy and currency of content, as well as for relevance with the services available within the Metro North Hospital and Health Service.

Through HealthPathways, GPs can register to be part of the GP to GP referrals initiative, which allows GPs to use the skills of other GPs as a convenient alternative to referring to a public or private specialist.
