The Path to Living Well with Dementia

Timely diagnosis

Talk to your GP or another doctor if you are concerned about your memory, thinking or any changes in behaviour.

- Seek investigation of your symptoms as soon as possible to support early diagnosis.
- Having a regular GP lets you build an ongoing relationship where your health needs are understood.

Assessment of dementia

Your doctor will arrange a variety of tests and referral to a specialist for diagnosis of dementia. Assessments and tests may include:

- detailed medical history
- memory assessment
- CT or MRI (neuroimaging of your brain)
- blood and urine tests
- review of other health conditions.

Caring for you and your carers

Taking the time to understand your diagnosis is important and your family and carers may experience a range of emotions. You can seek help and support by connecting with your community and support services, to:

- learn about dementia
- find a support group
- connect carers with support services
- talk to your doctor about your care needs.

Maintaining your health and wellbeing

Many people live well with dementia for a number of years.

Maintaining your health and wellbeing will help you live well with dementia for as long as possible. It also may slow the progression of the disease into the later stages. There are a number of ways you can support your health, including:

- building a healthcare team
- ensuring good nutrition
- getting regular exercise
- maintaining independence
- maintaining social engagement and connection
- taking medications to manage cognitive decline symptoms and changed behaviours.

Living well

There are a number of practical strategies that can support you to live well in the community with a diagnosis of dementia, including:

- managing your finances
- using safety equipment
- using supportive aids
- ensuring your environment is dementia-friendly
- accessing transport support.

Planning for the future

Planning for the future is an important step for you and your family. What matters to you is important and there are healthcare, legal and financial matters to consider such as:

- understanding respite
- advanced care directive
- enduring power of attorney
- financial legal support and updating wills.

Learning about dementia

Understanding dementia

Dementia is a collection of symptoms caused by disorders affecting the brain. It is not one specific disease. Dementia affects thinking, behaviour and the ability to perform everyday tasks. Dementia can happen to anyone and the risk of dementia increases with age. Most people with dementia are older, but not all older people develop dementia.

What are the early signs of dementia?

The early signs of dementia are very subtle and vague with symptoms varying depending on the type of dementia. It is generally progressive, where symptoms begin slowly and gradually worsen over time. It is important to remember that no two people experience dementia in the same way. People often lead active and fulfilling lives for many years after their diagnosis.

Some of the common symptoms and signs include:

- progressive and frequent memory loss
- confusion and difficulty thinking, understanding and concentrating
- changed behaviours, such as agitation and depression
- apathy and withdrawal
- impairment of perception
- communication difficulties affecting reading, writing and speech
- reduced ability to perform activities of daily living.

Understanding the different types of dementia

There are many types of dementia. The varying forms of dementia impact the brain differently, which means the experience of dementia is highly individual but has similar themes across the same forms.

It is important to identify the form of dementia you or someone you care for may be diagnosed with, as that will help with setting goals for the future and understanding changing behaviours.

The services available to you

The Federal Government provides a number of funded home care services to support older people in continuing to live well at home.

There are three types of government-funded support services available:

1. Commonwealth Home Support Program

This is the Australian Government's home help and respite program for older people who need some help with daily tasks so they can live independently at home. If you want to access this 'entry level' support, someone from the local assessment service will visit you for a basic assessment of your needs.

2. Commonwealth home care packages (Levels 1–4)

This is the Australian Government's more involved home care support, offered at different levels of need (from Level 1 through to highest needs at Level 4). If you want to access these care packages, someone from the assessment team will need to visit you to conduct a comprehensive assessment of your needs.

3. Respite

Respite care supports carers by giving them a break for a short period of time. There are different forms of respite care available including flexible, overnight, residential and emergency.

Flexible respite

This is aimed at low support needs and helping carers to relax and recharge with support workers providing day and overnight care at home. An assessment is required for government funded services. You can contact individual providers directly, starting on page 22.

Emergency residential respite care

Emergency respite care can be arranged through the Carers Gateway. In the North Brisbane region, this is delivered through Wellways. You can contact them directly on **1800 422 737**.

Overnight respite in a respite cottage

This is for people with low support needs. An assessment is required for government funded services.

Overnight residential respite

To access respite in a residential home (overnight short-term stays, for up to 63 days per year), an assessment and approval is required.

Residential care/permanent placement

If a person needs to move into a residential care home on a permanent basis, and they need Australian Government funding to support that placement, they will first need to be assessed by their local assessors. You are expected to contribute to the cost of your aged care if you can afford it. The amount you will pay for aged care is dependent on the type of care you are eligible for and the provider you choose.

How to access My Aged Care services

Please see the steps below to access government subsidised home care.

Step 1: Call My Aged Care on 1800 200 422

The government directs everyone to begin their search for aged care through its national contact centre and website, called 'My Aged Care' (MAC). Here you can access the government-funded services available.

MAC services include:

- help at home
- social support
- personal care
- transport
- residential aged care.

The MAC staff will ask you about your situation and needs.

If you're acting on someone's behalf, MAC will need to know you have their permission to proceed. Registration also requires a Medicare number.

Depending on your initial discussion with MAC and your eligibility, the MAC staff may organise for a free assessment to take place over the phone, in your or the person's home or in hospital if necessary.

Step 2. Your assessment

You will receive a call from an assessment team to schedule an appointment for an assessor to visit you at home.

Step 3. Preparing for assessment

An assessor will visit your home or call you on the day of your scheduled appointment to discuss your current needs and goals.

A family member or support person is welcome to attend the assessment.

You need to have ready on the assessment day:

- two forms of ID (Medicare card/drivers licence/DVA card/ pension card/passport)
- any referral forms (e.g. GP referral)
- details of previous services
- list of medications
- list of health conditions.

Step 4. Assessment outcome

Depending on the assessment outcome, you or the person being assessed may be eligible to receive Commonwealth Home Support Services.

The assessor will attempt to source appropriate service providers on your behalf at your visit and you will be given a referral number/s.

You can also find service providers yourself. You can check for services in your area by calling MAC or by using the 'Find a provider tool' on their website (myagedcare.gov.au/find-a-provider). You can also find local service providers from page 22 of this booklet. When you choose a service provider, give them the referral code/s you received from the assessor so they can start organising care for you.

When picking the best provider for you, there are a few things to keep in mind. Each organisation will offer services in a unique way and may charge a different fee. Before making a decision, consider your own preferences, availabilities of services, your needs, budget, and location.

If you've been assessed to receive a home care package, you will be sent a letter advising you've been assigned a package to meet your needs. There may be a wait to receive this package.

Step 5. Managing your services

You can change your MAC services if your situation changes.

This might include changing when your services are delivered, the type of care you receive and your service provider (the organisation who delivers your services).

You can do this by logging onto your MAC online account or speaking directly to your provider.

Do you need an interpreter?

People who speak a language other than English can connect with other services with the help of an interpreter through Translating and Interpreting Services (TIS). You can call TIS on 131 450 (24/7, for the cost of a local call) and they will organise an interpreter for you. Alternatively, if you contact a service directly, they may organise an interpreter on your behalf.

Do you have a hearing or speech impairment?

People who are deaf or have a hearing or speech impairment can contact health services using the National Relay Service.

If you can access the internet, check their website for their communication options at relayservice.gov.au.

What other help is available?

National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS)

This Commonwealth Government program provides funding for people under the age of 65 with a permanent and significant disability. It can connect people living with dementia to reasonable and necessary supports and services to help in daily life.

The support scheme can help you maintain independence and connect with the community. Support can be accessed for people under 65 years old (and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people under 50 years old) who are not eligible for NDIS.

The Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) helps veterans of the Australian Defence Forces (Gold or White Card holders only) access home care services. To request an assessment, contact the Veterans' Home Care Assessment Agency.

Private care

Many companies and organisations offer fee-for-service home care. You don't need an assessment or to speak with MAC, and you can contact organisations directly to find out what care they provide. You choose what services you want to purchase and are responsible for paying the full costs. This option is ideal if you:

- need home care services immediately
- are looking to specifically tailor your care to meet the exact services you need
- are waiting for government funding, but need care services while you wait
- are under the age of 65 and not eligible for government funding.

Help navigating aged care services

If you are struggling, there are services to help you navigate aged care services and people who can advocate on your behalf. There are also paid private navigators available to help with care coordination.

Navigation support services

OPAN provides free information about aged care services to help you navigate your journey. In some cases, there are intensive support navigators who can offer one-on-one assistance.


