



## Fully Funded Environmental Design Audits | **For Residential Aged Care organisations** in the Brisbane North PHN region

As part of the 'Enhancing Dementia Care' project commissioned by Brisbane North PHN, we are pleased to offer residential aged care facilities the opportunity to undertake an Environmental Design Audit.

The purpose of the audit is to provide a systematic assessment of your built environment as it currently stands so as to identify areas for improvement. There are over 70 aspects of the built environment that are assessed during the audit with the focus on the impact of the environment on the person/resident living with dementia. A written report with details of the audit and recommendations will be provided to you.

The audit visit takes approximately 2 – 3 hours and involves a Dementia Australia Consultant working with managers, staff and residents. Audits will be undertaken on an existing unit (up to 30 beds).

**Preferred criteria:** Your Facility - must be located within the Brisbane North PHN region, be a not for profit, have a dementia unit older than 10 years, not undertaken an Environmental Audit in last 5 years. If you do not meet this criteria please call us to discuss 07 3138 5943.
