Qld Respiratory and Sleep Clinical Network are seeking expressions of interest from:

- GPs who have an interest/passion in respiratory and sleep care and health services

Clinical Excellence Queensland's Healthcare Improvement Unit invites expressions of interest for a General Practitioner to join the Queensland Respiratory and Sleep Clinical Network (QRSCN) Steering Committee. Steering Committee membership is for a 2-year period commencing in February 2024.

The purpose of the network is to develop collaboration between multidisciplinary Respiratory and Sleep specialists, primary and secondary health care providers consumers and consumer advocates to develop strategies to mitigate existing gaps, particularly access to multidisciplinary and specialist services, embed sustainability into services and to facilitate ongoing quality improvements.

The goal of the network is to provide expertise, direction and review of clinical services, education, and research and to liaise with external service providers and consumers, to work towards improvements in service delivery to patients requiring respiratory and sleep services in Queensland. Steering Committee members will be required to provide high level advice (and feedback) to improve the quality of care, service delivery and the efficiency and planning of respiratory and sleep services across Queensland.

Role of the GP Representative

The role of the GP representative on the QSHCN is to:

- Actively participate in discussions and meetings
- Confidently advocate on behalf of GPs
- Bring a GP perspective to all discussions and decision-making
- Review meeting papers in advance and respond to out of session business via email as required
- Promote the activities and resources of the network and provide linkages with other potential strategic partners
- Identify future opportunities and improvements in relation to the network



Requirements

- Participation in monthly one-hour meetings, via Microsoft Teams.
- Attendance at the annual steering committee planning workshop.
- Participate on sub-groups or working groups as required.
- Actively consult on network correspondence and requests for information.
- Feedback information through your team, service, and organisation.

Confidentiality

In accordance with the Hospital and Health Boards Act (2011), QRSCN Steering Committee members are required to maintain confidentiality of discussions, meeting materials and business of the QRSCN Steering Committee.

Remuneration and Support

The successful GP will be reimbursed for their time at the meeting as per *Queensland Health Guidelines.
