





Environmental Design Audits | For Residential Aged Care organisations in the Brisbane North PHN

As part of the 'Enhancing Dementia Care' project run by Brisbane North PHN, we are pleased to offer residential aged care facilities the opportunity to undertake an Environmental Design Audit.

The purpose of the audit is to provide a systematic assessment of your built environment as it currently stands so as to identify areas for improvement. There are over 70 aspects of the built environment that are assessed during the audit with the focus on the impact of the environment on the person/resident living with dementia.

The audit visit takes approximately 2-3 hours and involves a Dementia Australia Consultant working with managers, staff and residents.

To be eligible for this service your facility must be located within the Brisbane North PHN catchment, be a not for profit; have a dementia unit older than 10 years; not undertaken a Dementia Environmental Audit in last 5 years. Audits will be undertaken on an existing unit (up to 30 beds). One facility per organisation.
