The Queensland Maternal and Perinatal Quality Council (QMPQC) is seeking expressions of interest from clinicians and professionals with expertise in maternity, neonatal, and perinatal care to join the Council and its three subcommittees.

About QMPQC

The QMPQC is a statutory council established under the *Hospital and Health Boards Act 2011*. Its purpose is to:

- Monitor and report on maternal and perinatal mortality and morbidity in Queensland
- Identify trends, risk factors, and opportunities for system-wide improvement
- Provide expert advice to Queensland Health on strategies to improve outcomes for mothers and babies

The Council is supported by three subcommittees:

1. *Maternal Mortality and Morbidity Subcommittee*
2. *Perinatal Mortality and Morbidity Subcommittee*
3. *Neonatal Morbidity Subcommittee*

Each subcommittee undertakes detailed case reviews, data analysis, and contributes to the Council's annual reporting and recommendations.
