# Initial Assessment and Referral Decision Support Tool (IAR-DST) training



The IAR-DST is an initiative by the Department of Health and Aged Care and complements clinical judgement when recommending mental health support.

The IAR-DST assists GPs and other referrers in confidently supporting patients with mental health concerns and helping them finding the most appropriate, localised care – at any age or stage. Training now covers specific rating guides for children (aged 5 to 11), adolescents (aged 12 to 17), adults (aged 18 to 64) and older adults (aged 65 and over).
