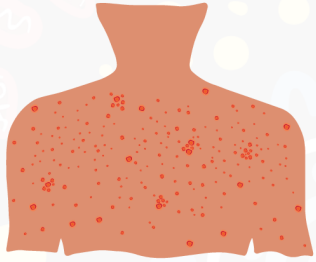


How Does Mpox Spread?



Direct contact with infected bodily fluids, including contact with sores or scabs on the skin.

Touching objects that an infected person has used, including bedding or towels.



During close physical contact, including sex.

Face-to-face contact by breathing infected droplets from coughing or sneezing.

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Mpox can include the following symptoms:

Rash or sores on any part of the body



Fever over 38 degrees Celsius

Swollen lymph nodes



Headaches, body aches and tiredness

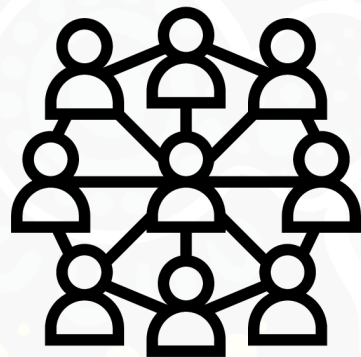
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Who do I yarn with about Mpox?
