1. Article contributions

The PHN offers publication of articles, at no cost, for relevant content supplied by not-for-profit health related organisations, including:

- public-funded health services
- community groups (health related)
- health related services / providers offering free or subsidised health and lifestyle programs for the general public and are considered to be of broad benefit to our community
- word limit: 200-250 words
- must include a call-to-action for more information (i.e. a URL, email address or phone number).

2. Noticeboard

The Noticeboard section of Network Link offers space, at no cost, for brief items from any health related organisations and community groups, including private/ for-profit services.

- word limit: 100 words
- must be relevant to a health audience, e.g. service announcements, professional resources
- can include click-through URLs
- must include a call-to-action for more information (i.e. a URL, email address or phone number).
