- Conduct client activity groups and programs individually or in groups under direction of the Occupational Therapist
- Document activity in client medical record as appropriate to role and under direction of the Occupational Therapist
- Organise equipment for in-home trial as per Occupational Therapist recommendations
- Deliver and demonstrate use of equipment for in-home trial and adjust equipment according to specifications from the Occupational Therapist
- Provide education on the safe use of equipment in the home environment
- Complete client follow up and review as per Occupational Therapist instructions
- Assist in development and ongoing update of client resources for community education and chronic disease management
