Role-specific

 lead the organisation's payroll functions, including accurate and timely payment of superannuation and salary packaging, processing termination payments, preparation of payment summaries, calculation of leave entitlements and maintenance of payroll records for each employee.



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- provide support to staff by addressing payroll-related queries in a timely manner.
- ensure tax compliance of payroll functions including STP, SuperStream and PAYG processing.
- administer all accounts receivable and payable, including preparation of electronic funds transfers,
 maintenance of accounting records and liaison with creditors
- administer the organisation's funds using appropriate banking and investment strategies and the proper recording of transactions
- provide support and guidance to the Accounts Payable Officer with regards to the processing and payment of invoices
- participate in providing information to the organisation's external auditors during the interim and end-offinancial year audit.

- experience in the administration of business accounts, particularly the management of accounts payable and receivable and the preparation of financial reports within tight deadlines
- knowledge of basic accounting principles
- advanced skills in Microsoft Word, Outlook and Excel
- experience developing strong working relationships with executive management, managers and peers

- experience using ELMO payroll system desirable
- knowledge of the primary healthcare industry or ability to acquire that knowledge quickly is highly desirable.
