

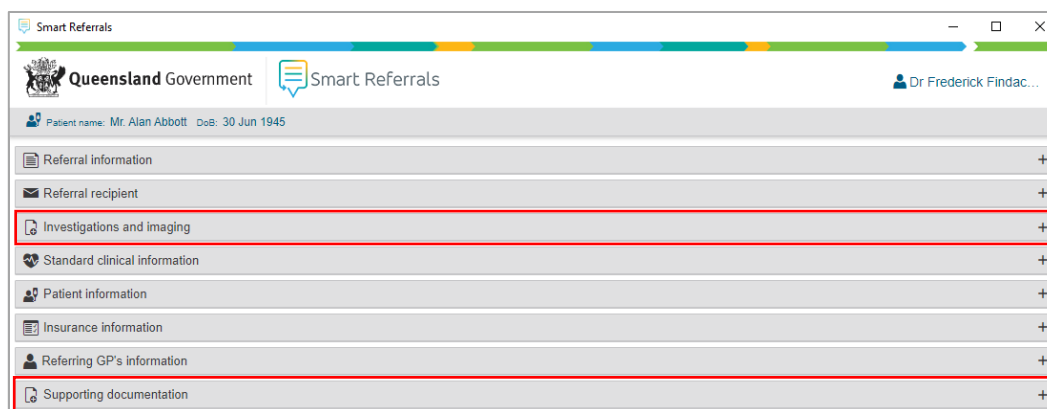

#### Attachment and Investigation Collection

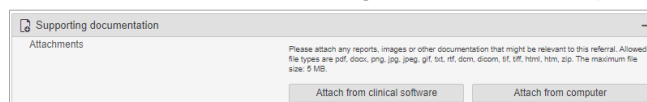
##### Investigations and Imaging – New Section

A new section has been created called 'Investigations and Imaging'. The new Investigations and Imaging section sits between Specialty form and Standard clinical information sections.




##### Supporting Documentation – Renamed Section

The Recent investigations table has been moved to the new Investigations and Imaging section and is no longer in the Standard clinical information section





## Enhanced File Viewing

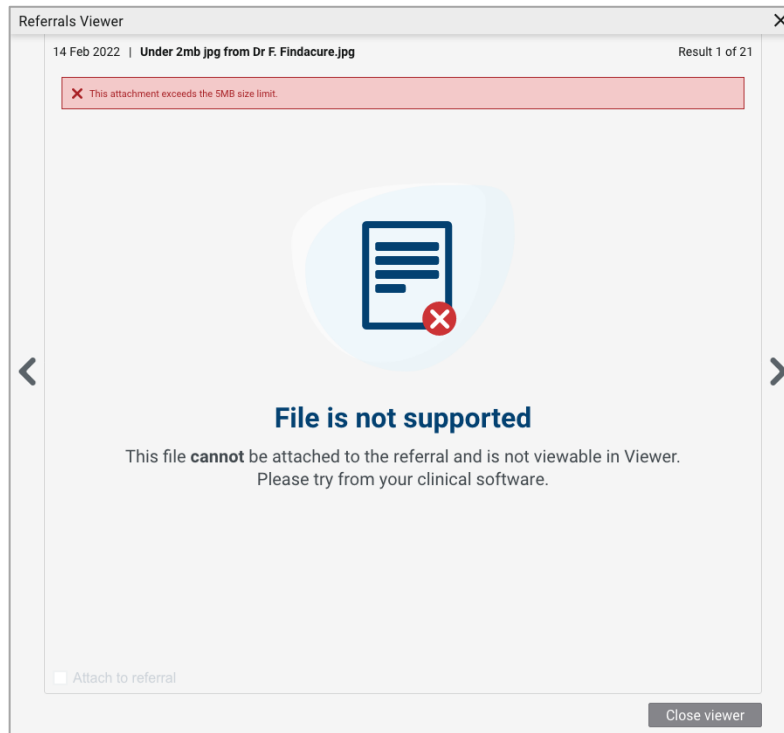
### File viewer messaging

Files that are valid but cannot be rendered will now display an 'unrenderable' message.

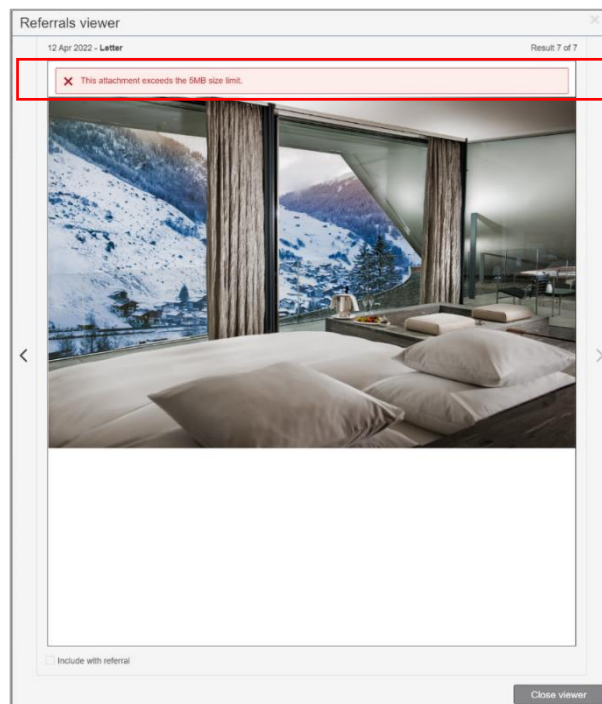

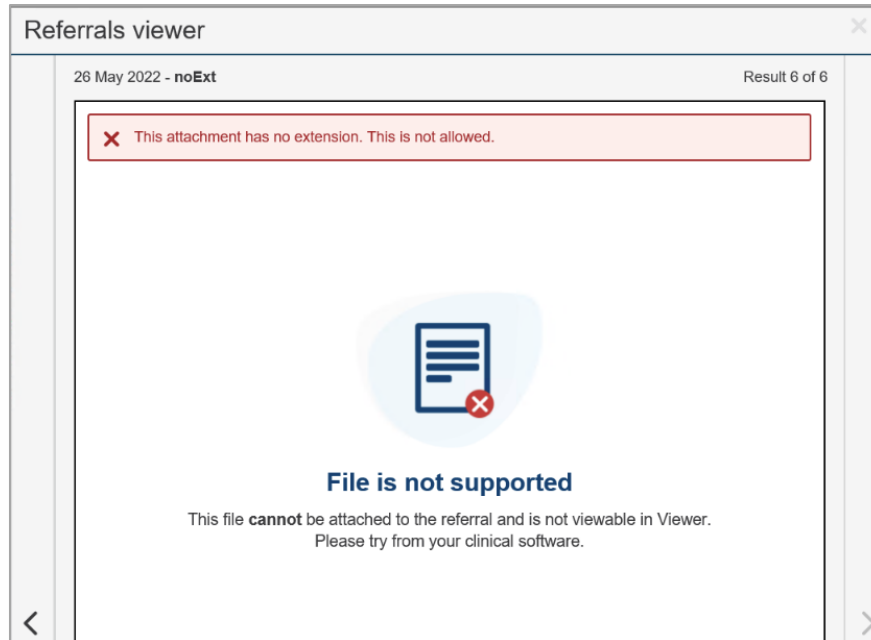

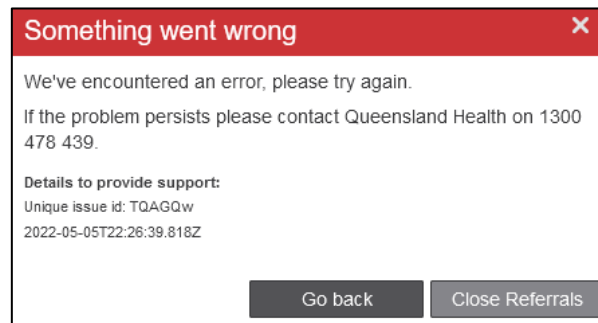
## File viewer content resized to fit window

## Secure Correspondence Integration

Hospital and Health Service staff are now able to send Secure Correspondence to the GP's Practice Management Software. GP Smart Referrals will now process show the event for 'Correspondence Received in PMS' in the referral history table. Correspondence Received will update in the referral history table and the status of the referral will remain the existing status.
