## **CAT4** recipes

#### Identify patients at risk for Influenza based on age, ethnicity or pregnancy

At risk groups include:

- Patients ≥ 65 years of age
- Indigenous patients ≥ 6 months of age
- Pregnant women

#### Identify patients at risk for influenza with predisposing conditions

Patients ≥ 6 months of age with conditions predisposing to severe influenza; these include: CHD, Heart failure, COPD, Asthma, Diabetes and Renal failure.
