

Improving cancer screening across our region– Funding is available to improve cervical and bowel cancer screening in your practice

Brisbane North PHN can provide payments, funded by Queensland Health’s Cancer Screening Unit, to practices undertaking Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) activities to increase cervical and bowel cancer screening rates.

Practices may choose up to four CQI activities outlined in the [Cancer Screening Practice Payments guide](#). You may also develop practice-specific activities that you believe will improve the outcomes for your patient population.

To access funding

Express interest by completing Part One of the [Continuous Quality Improvement Plan](#) and submit via email to practicesupport@brisbanenorth.org.au at Brisbane North PHN. This planning document will ask you to outline goals you want to achieve, which activities you want to implement, timelines you will be working to, and how you will measure your progress.

Brisbane North PHN will review your EOI and inform successful applicants who will receive an initial payment of \$250.

Your practice will undertake proposed activities with the support of your Brisbane North PHN QI&D Engagement Officer between the period of February 2025 to April 2025.

At project close, you will complete Part Two of the [Continuous Quality Improvement Plan](#) and submit to Brisbane North PHN to receive your completion payment.
