To celebrate Women's Health Week, Brisbane North PHN in partnership with our region's two Endometriosis and Pelvic Pain GP Clinics is pleased to present a webinar for local health professionals with a focus on endometriosis and pelvic pain.

In 2023 two clinics in the North Brisbane and Moreton Bay region were selected by the Department of Health and Aged Care to pilot new models of care to support individuals experiencing endometriosis and pelvic pain.

Participants will hear directly from the GPs and allied health providers delivering these services to understand the unique model of care each clinic provides, gain insight into lessons learned during their implementation, and learn how to refer in or support your own patients experiencing these conditions.

- explain the background and context of the Department of Health's endometriosis and pelvic pain clinics
- identify the two endometriosis and pelvic pain clinics in the PHN region
- appropriately refer to the two endometriosis and pelvic pain clinics

- source appropriate support and resources for people experiencing endometriosis and pelvic pain.
