Redcliffe Safe Space	The Safe Space model of service delivery has been developed using a consultative process with lived experience representatives and health service providers in the respective catchment areas of North Brisbane. The successful service provider will also undertake additional codesign with the Redcliffe community, including people with a lived experience of distress and/or suicidal crisis and health professionals to ensure the service meets the specific needs of this catchment. It is expected that the successful service provider will honour the findings of the initial Codesign and address recommendations for further codesign to include further consultation with priority population groups, and how to ensure a no wrong door approach to service delivery, identified in the summary report.
