headspace Taringa relocates to Indooroopilly

One of Australia's busiest headspace centres at Taringa has relocated to larger premises at Indooroopilly to keep up with growing demand from young people with mild to moderate mental illness.

The new site at 17 Station Road, Indooroopilly is closer to public transport and Indooroopilly Shopping Centre, offering clients convenience and better access.

"The Taringa centre had expanded over the past four years, but due to a limited number of consultation spaces we were unable to recruit additional practitioners to meet demand," said headspace regional manager Jamie Thompson. "Indooroopilly has 20 consultation rooms, an increase from 12 rooms at Taringa."

Projections indicate the new centre will have capacity for 12,500 consultations a year—a significant increase from a capacity of 7,500 at Taringa.

Twenty-six per cent of young people aged 0 to 17 years in Brisbane north region are estimated to have a mental health condition.

Brisbane North PHN has responsibility for commissioning Australian Government-funded youth mental health services in its region and supports five headspace centres in north Brisbane: Caboolture, Nundah, Redcliffe, Strathpine and now Indooroopilly.

Executive Manager for Commissioned Services at Brisbane North PHN, Paul Martin, said the relocation to the Indooroopilly site would improve functioning of the local health system and meet a growing need for mental health services for young people aged 12-25 in the region.

"The PHN is committed to supporting the goals of Planning for Wellbeing, the region's five-year mental health plan to improve the lives of those affected by mental illness, suicide, or problematic substance use," said Mr Martin.
