## School Readiness Program

#### School Readiness Program Overview

- Currently operating from two early education centres in Caboolture and a playgroup in Redcliffe, with opportunity to expand.
- Facilitates linkages to local primary healthcare services to ensure improved health outcomes to children.

#### **Our Approach:**

- Allied Health Professionals (AHPs) including occupational therapists and speech pathologists, screen children for developmental issues.
- If developmental delay is identified, AHPs construct a support plan informing parents/caregivers of their children's progress while working with teachers/child carers to support these children.

#### **Results:**

- Increased school readiness by 70%
- Successful proof-of-concept found children improved in one year by:
  - **21**% social
  - 50% gross motor
  - 25.5% language skills

(foundational development milestone needs for school)

- Better assessment, therapies, and professionals for children with developmental delays and neurodiverse conditions including that are linked to Mental Health.
- Identification and response to the pockets in North Brisbane and Moreton Bay where children are developmentally vulnerable.



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
