The Primary Care Advisory Group (PCAG) is a non-clinical advisory group that provides practical, role-specific advice to help shape PHN projects and initiatives impacting general practice and Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations (ACCHOs) across North Brisbane and Moreton Bay.

Expressions of interest are now open for applicants currently working a minimum of three days in general practice or ACCHOs, in the following roles:


- general practitioners
- practice managers or operational managers
- medical receptionists and administrative staff
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health workers
- general practice nurses (enrolled nurses, registered nurses, nurse practitioners)
- medical practice assistants.

This is an opportunity to bring the voice of primary care into co-design, influence initiatives before rollout and contribute to meaningful system improvement.

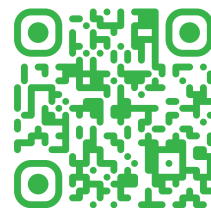
